

Regulations for the award of the title "German Champion Club":

The Chow Chow needs to win four CAC (Certificate d'Apitute au Championat) in Germany with those wins being under at least three different judges with at least 12 months interval between the first and last certificate in order to become German Champion Club. Only those Chows awarded an "Excellent 1" can get the CAC. The Chow Chow in intermediate class with the result "Excellent 1, Anw. German Ch. VDH", the Chow Chow in open class with the result "Excellent 1, Anw. German Ch. VDH" and the Chow Chow in champion class with the result "Excellent 1, Anw. German Ch. VDH" must go in competition, the better one will get the CAC. The Chow Chow with the result "Excellent 2" will get the reserve challenge certificate (Res. CAC).

Regulations for the award of the title "German Youth Champion Club":

The junior dog needs to win three "Anw. German Youth Champion Club" under at least two different judges to become German Youth Champion Club.

Regulations for the award of the title "German Veteran Champion Club":

The rules for the "German Veteran Champion Club" are the same rules as for the German Veteran Champion (VDH). That means, the veteran needs to win three "Anw. German Vet.-Ch. Club" under at least two different judges to become German Veteran Champion Club.
